The Chair of Architectural History invites you to participate in an excursion and a workshop that tackles issues related to housing, architectural history and urban studies.

In this one-week project, students will be part of a series of activities; including a workshop, city walks and visits to housing projects and sites. The project culminates with the opening of the exhibition "Habitar Lisboa" in the Centro Cultural de Belém.

This study trip is developed in the scope of a Blended Intensive Programme, an Erasmus mobility format developed as an intensive and interdisciplinary course, in which both students and lecturers receive funding to help covering the travel expenses.

Up to 15 students are entitled to receive a per diem paid by the GU (70EUR for at least five days) and a minimum of 6 ECTS credits shall be awarded.
